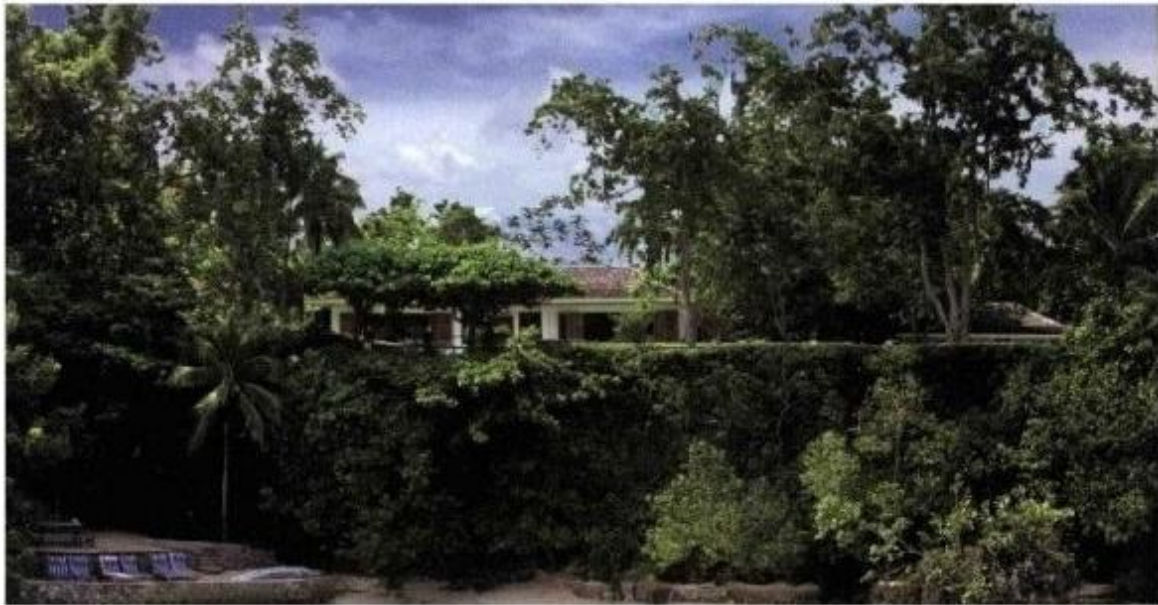


## STAR TURN
